# Notification of "COVID-19 Vaccine Coupon"

## Eligible persons for the coupon

- Those registered in the Basic Resident Register of Okayama City as of the date of send-out of this notification and aged 65 or over as of March 31, 2022 (persons who are born before April 1, 1957).
- ※ For persons aged under 65, the coupon will be posted when the time for vaccination approaches. Therefore, the date of receiving the coupon may be different even among your family members.

## Important notice of vaccinations

- Consent of the person is required to take the vaccines. For those who have chronic disease(s), please consult with your family doctor.
- You are responsible for making a reservation for vaccinations. You can reserve at one of the medical institutions of which we inform you later.
- Before visiting a medical institution, please fill out a medical questionnaire in advance.
- You are required to receive two doses of vaccine.
- Please keep the enclosed vaccine coupon until you complete the second vaccine.

# Vaccination Process

Vaccines cost:  
free of charge.

## 1 Confirm when to get your vaccines

COVID-19 vaccines are scheduled to begin sequentially with healthcare staff, senior citizens, those with pre-existing illnesses, etc. Please confirm when you are supposed to get your vaccine and wait until your turns come.

- ※ This notification was made based on information available as of mid-February, 2021. For updated announcement and information from the Japanese government, you can visit the websites of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare and Okayama City.
- ※ Vaccines will be so provided that all who wish to be vaccinated can receive them. You may have to wait a little while, but please rest assured you will get the vaccine.

## 2 Confirm where to get your vaccines/vaccine sites

Please look for a medical institution or vaccination site where you can be vaccinated via the public notices from Okayama City or Internet.

- ※ If you cannot find a medical institution or vaccine site, please call the following call center.
- ※ You can be vaccinated at your registered municipality based on your certificate of residence unless you are currently hospitalized or in a care or nursing facility. Concerning a vaccination site outside of your registered municipality, please inquire of the hospital, medical institution and care or nursing facility where you stay or municipality where you live.



## 3 Make an appointment and receive a vaccine

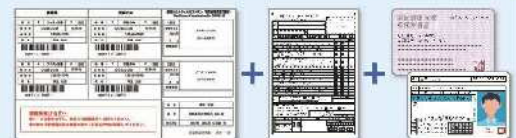

- Vaccine coupon (enclosed in this envelop)
- Medical questionnaire (enclosed in this envelop)
- Identity confirmation document (driver's license, health insurance card, etc.)



- Before receiving a vaccine, please take your temperature at home. In case you obviously have a fever or you do not feel well, please refrain from receiving a vaccine and contact the medical institution which you reserved.
- Wear clothes that allow for easy vaccine access.
- You will be asked to sit for 15-30 minutes after vaccination to ensure you have no reactions.
- Two doses of the same type must be given at a certain intervals in order to get the full effect of the vaccine. Please confirm at the medical institution when you should receive the second vaccination after you have had the first one.
- The enclosed sheet has a two-dose "vaccination coupon" and a "vaccination certificate". Please bring the enclosed when you get each vaccination.
